STARSKATE FIGURE SKATING PROGRAM

Note: The CanSkate Learn to Skate program is also offered. Please see our CanSkate brochure for more information.

SESSION LEVELS

Pre-Star PROGRAM (NEW!!!): Our Pre-Star Program is available to those who have a desire to further their Figure Skating skills, and is intended to provide both the skater and the parent with an "Introduction to Figure Skating". The program is open to all skaters that are at the CanSkate Stage 4 level and above who are interested in figure skating.

The program consists of a 50-minute CanSkate session followed by a 30-minute group session. CanSkate allows the skaters to continue working on their basic and advanced skating skills while earning ribbons and badges. The Pre-Star group session offers group lessons introducing the skaters to figure skating skills and elements.

Coaching fees for CanSkate and the Pre-Star group sessions are included in the registration fees.

Coaching fees for any additional private lessons are invoiced directly to the parent by their coach. A list of coaches is provided below and on the Club website.

Pre-Star Privates (NEW!): This is part of the Pre-Star Program (new). This session is intended to provide both the skater and the parent with an "Introduction to Figure Skating". Skaters will work on their own or in small groups with their coach. Skaters must have an individual coach before starting this program. Private lessons are arranged with an individual coach prior to the start of the session. If you do not have a coach, please contact the club. Pre-Star Private registration fees cover the cost of the ice only.

Coaching fees for private lessons are invoiced directly to the parent by their coach. A list of coaches is provided below and on the Club website.

StarSkate:

Star 1: Skaters who have passed their Stage 6 badge and are working on their Star 1 Tests.

Star 2: Skaters who have passed one skating test, or their Star 1 FreeSkate test or both their Star 1 Skills & Dance tests.

Star 3: Skaters who have passed at least one Preliminary test, or their Star 2 FreeSkate test, or both Star 2 Skills & Dance.

Star 4: Skaters who have passed all of their Preliminary FreeSkate test, or their Star 3 tests or both their Star 3 Skills and Dance tests.

Star 5: Skaters who have passed all their Junior Bronze FreeSkate test or their Star 4 FreeSkate test or both their Star 4 Skills & Dance tests or higher.

AdultSkate: This program is for adults who are at the preliminary freeskate level and above. This is NOT a learn to skate program.

Adult/Teen/Pre-Teen Learn to Skate: This Learn-to-Skate program is for Adults, Teens and Pre-Teens. The program will cover the basic fundamentals of skating in a group lesson format by a NCCP certified professional coach. The Learn-To-Skate program is designed for Pre-Teens (age 12) through to Adults. The program will provide skaters the opportunity to improve their current skating and achieve new skills from the national CanSkate program including forwards and backwards skating and stopping. CSA approved hockey helmets are mandatory for all skaters who have not completed the Stage 5 badge of the CanSkate program. Please note skates are not available for rental at the arena.

REGISTRATION

Registration for StarSkate is online only:

All fees must be paid in full prior to any skater being permitted on the ice. Payment may be made online via credit card. The board and/or coach have the right to not allow the skater on the ice until such time as all outstanding balances have been paid. Registration fee includes RSC membership, insurance for the skater, ice, program fees, and the **non-refundable Skate Canada Membership fee of \$36** for the skater. Register before September 15, 2017 to obtain Early Bird pricing. Full fees apply from September 15, 2017.

Outstanding Fees: Where a skater has an amount owing to the RSC for an extended period of time (more than 30 days), the Board and / or Professional Coach has the right to not allow the skater on the ice until all outstanding balances have been paid. RSC reserves the right to inform Skate Canada and other clubs of accounts that are not in good standing.

Refunds: Refunds will only be granted for medical reasons. Please refer to our Refund policy posted on our website (www.rideauskating.ca) for full details.

Test Day Fees: Test Days will be held as determined by the Executive and subject to the availability of evaluators and officials. Rideau Members will be invoiced for test fees. Non-Members must pay fees prior to testing. Skaters may be required to take tests at other skating clubs, and will be responsible for their own fees and associated expenses.

Guest Skating and Training Ice: RSC members are granted unlimited guest skating/training ice, and will be invoiced by the Club. Approval of Guest skating for non-members is at the discretion of the Registrar. Non-members **MUST** pay prior to guest skating.

REGULATIONS

Rideau Skating Club (RSC) reserves the right to move skaters between classifications, depending on the skater's ability and the professional coaches' recommendations. RSC reserves the right to change/cancel sessions and ice times depending on registration, and club requirements. All changes and/or cancellations will be posted on the Club's website. Skaters registering with the club must abide by the RSC rules, also posted on the Club's website. Skaters may not substitute one day of skating for another without prior permission from the registrar.
